

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) CATCH-UP PREMIUM:

This year, schools have been allocated extra funds to support students who will have missed learning opportunities in light of the national and regional lockdowns. Government announced that schools will be allocated £80 for each student from Year 7 to 11 and £150 for each student in Year 12 and 13 who have not yet achieved a GCSE grade 4 or above in Maths and/or English.

Below is the current Catch Up funding plan, which is likely to develop as time progresses and we measure the impact of the initiatives used through the year.

Item	Description
Academic Mentors	Extra staff members to work with small groups in specific subjects to catch up in KS4 and 5 and support revision sessions
Creating extra computer room	Venue dedicated for the online tutoring and place for academic mentoring to occur Computers, webcams and earphones also needed
Online tutoring through the National Tutoring Programme	Around 150 students in KS4 in 3-1 online tutoring sessions, 2 cycles of 15 hours over 6/7 weeks KS5 online tuition 3-1 online, 10 week programme
Love Literacy Programme	3 days a week, January – May, offering support for Yr7 and 8 English and Maths catch up and Yr10 and 11 English catch up
Online subscriptions	To allow students to work on gaps and areas that need development independently in school or at home
Revision Guides	Purchased for students to use in and out of school in conjunction with the work teachers are doing in and out of lessons
Externally marked PPEs	To support students and teachers identify the gaps in knowledge and skills, and inform them of the next steps
LRC Open after school for Yr11 independent study	Staffed from November to June
Star Maths	Used to baseline the incoming Yr7 students, provide all stakeholders with info about how to improve and move forward
Year 12/13 Maths GCSE Resit support	Enhanced enrichment support for Year 12 and 13 students in Maths Resit GCSE. Weekly virtual lessons on TEAMS by expert Maths teacher
Self Isolating students working from home	Resources to allow students to work effectively at home and for SLT to ensure the work is being set
