We hope you are all well, safe, healthy, and having a lovely start to the summer.

We are writing to outline the plan for GCSE results day on **Thursday 12th August** and your Sixth Form transition conversations. The plan as laid out below is summarised on the following page with an annotated map to make things clear.

Students must enter and leave through the back entrance via Kinfauns Road and car park to the school when collecting results. Results cannot be collected by anyone else. If you are unable to attend for any reason, these will be posted to you. If you know in advance that you will not be able to attend to collect results, please email Mr Marsham at marshama@mayfieldschool.net to see if we can email these to you.

Students may collect results from 9.00am until 11.00am in Café Best. All students must be off site by 11.30am.

If you have applied to come to Mayfield Sixth Form, we will then have our transition conversations over two days, on Thursday 12th August from 12.00pm to 4:00pm and Friday 13th August from 9.00am to 4:00pm. These will be on the ground floor of the North Teaching Block and you will enter school again via the Kinfauns Road entrance. You will be sent an email with a specific conversation time over these two days. **You will only be seen on this day and time and not any other.** If, you cannot attend for whatever reason or haven't received your email, please contact Ms Sviderskyte at sviderskyteg@mayfieldschool.net.

If you have any school textbooks or equipment, please bring them back on Results Day. Likewise, if you would like to donate any part of your uniform, especially blazers, to be used by others in our community please bring them in on Results Day.

The start date for Year 12 is Friday 3rd September 2021, with registration at 8:45am. Please enter the school site via the Kinfauns Road gate.

Things to do before Sixth Form:

- Bank Account - **please open a bank account if you do not have one already.** This is important for many reasons, especially if you will be applying for the bursary, delaying this will delay your bursary payment.
- Uniform and school Policy - read and understand the uniform policy, blazers for male and female students are not optional, they are an expectation. Shoes not trainers, even if they are Prada or Armani.
- Complete the summer learning for your subject of interest - this will be updated on the school website by Thursday, 22nd July.
